Green Building Rating System:

Energy Efficiency and Sustainable Construction Standards for State Buildings

The Georgia Peach Green Building Rating System is a collection of standards and guidelines to provide more stringent energy and water efficiency requirements for future buildings that will be constructed by the State. These standards were developed by the 2008 Energy Efficiency and Sustainable Construction Task Force and became effective in July of 2010. The new standards apply to the construction, rehabilitation, and maintenance of state-funded facilities, including new construction and existing roof replacements. This presentation will discuss what types of construction projects these standards apply to, along with what new policies and procedures are associated with the standards.
