Instructors cover fundamentals of quality assurance, component assembly and quality practice guidelines for a variety of roofing systems, including: Role of the Roof Observer, Construction Contract Documents, Daily Reports, Low-Slope Roofing' Spray-Applied Foam, Steep-Slope Roofing, Ethics' and Codes.
